- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- \cdot "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- \cdot "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- \cdot "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates). "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- · "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
